				The SDWOs, after duly examining all the applications and ascertaining the correctness of the same in all respects shall place the consolidated lists of the students before the Sub-Divisional Level Beneficiary Selection Committees for approval. The committee on being satisfied with the list shall approve it and the SDWOs shall forward the duly approved list to the Directorate of Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare, Assam through the online system.
			1	The Director shall examine the lists submitted by all SDWOs and if found satisfied shall consolidate the lists and place the final list before the Chairman, State Level Advisory Committee (SLAC) for his/her approval. However, in due course of examinations, if an applicant/s is found doubtful the Director shall exercise the right to return the list to the concerned SDWO for re-verification.

				 The Pre-Matric Scholarship is awarded to students from Class-IX to Class-X and Post-Matric Scholarship is awarded to students pursuing studies from Class-XI to normal Three Years Degree Courses (BA, BBA, B.Com, B.Sc, Integrated Graduate + Post Graduate courses like integrated MBA/BA-LLB/BA-B.Ed./MSW, etc.). Undertaking on the annual family income stating that it is not exceeding Rs. 5.00 lakh per annum to be submitted by the Parent / Guardian (Annexure - 1).
