PCM SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION 2024 - 2025

CIRCULAR

The PCM Scholarship Examination offers a platform for students to compete and showcase their knowledge across various subjects. It evaluates scholastic aptitude, mental ability, conceptual clarity, and problem-solving skills, boosting their confidence for future competitive exams.

This year, the examination is open to students of LKG, UKG, and Classes 1 to 5.

I. Examination Pattern:

• Pre-Primary:

LKG: Oral and Activity-Oriented Test with picture support. UKG: Identification and Colouring Test with picture suppor

• Classes I to V: Written test.

The examination duration for all classes is 90 minutes. All registered candidates will appear for the final examination.

II. Examination Schedule:

• Date of Examination : 09 November, 2024 (Saturday)

• Time : 10:30 AM - 12:00 Noon

• Declaration of Results : 24 January, 2025 (Saturday)

Registration opens on 5 August, 2024, and closes on 1 September, 2024.

III. Eligibility:

English medium schools in Kerala following any Board of Examination syllabus can enrol students in LKG, UKG, and Classes 1 to 5. Separate examinations will be conducted for each class. Enrolment of candidates less than 20 numbers from pre-primary and less than 20 numbers from classes 1 to 5 from a school will not be accepted.

IV. Syllabus:

The syllabus is based on the academic curriculum of each level, with a focus on higher-order thinking skills such as application, analysis, synthesis, imagination, and creativity. Participating schools will receive copies of the syllabus for free distribution. The syllabus and specimen questions for each class are available at www.curriculumindia.com.

V. Fees:

The examination fee is Rs. 150 per candidate.

VI. Awards and Scholarships:

- 1st Position (each class): Rs. 10,000/- Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate
- 2nd Position (each class): Rs. 7,000/- Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate
- 3rd Position (each class): Rs. 5,000/- Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate
- 4th & 5th Positions (each class): Medals, Rs. 1,000/- Scholarship, and Merit Certificate
- **LKG and UKG:** Candidates scoring 90% and above will receive Medals, Rs. 500/- Scholarship, and Merit Certificates.
- Classes I to V: Candidates scoring 80% and above will receive Medals, Rs. 500/- Scholarship, and Merit Certificates.
- Merit Certificates: For candidates scoring 60% and above.
- School Awards: Schools with excellent results will be honoured with mementos.

VII. Registration Process:

All registrations must be completed online through our official website www.curriculumindia.com.

- .• Entering of Student Information: Schools must submit the following information for each participating student: Full Name, Class, Division, Parent's Name, and Parent's Mobile Number
- Fee Payment: Payments are to be made by parents via a payment portal link sent to their mobile numbers. Upon successful transaction, a receipt will be issued. The school can verify the registration status on the website.

VIII. Examination Centres:

Participating schools will serve as examination centres for their students. External invigilators will be appointed and honorarium will be paid to them directly by us. Schools are requested to provide necessary support and facilities.

IX. Staff Appointment for Proctoring:

Schools are requested to allow PCM Council to use their teachers as invigilators/examiners at neighbouring centres. Interested teachers should register online and will receive an honorarium.

We request you to designate a teacher / staff member as a 'SPOC' (specific person of contact) and submit the name and contact number at the time of registration.

X. Results and Presentation of Awards:

Results will be published on 24 January, 2025 (Saturday) on our website www.curriculumindia.com. A special function will be held to honour the candidates who win the top three positions from each class and the schools with commendable performance. Medals, scholarships, certificates, and trophies will be presented. All other scholarships and certificates will be sent to the respective schools.
